The End of an Era

The Seamanship class starting 2 December will be the last Seamanship class given. The United States Power Squadrons has offered Seamanship as the first of the Advanced Grade classes for decades. In 2017, USPS announced that Seamanship would be phased

out and a new course, Boat Handling, would take its place. Starting in 2018, the pilot version of Boat Handling was released as a trial for any Squadron interested in trying it. At that time, it was obvious that Seamanship had its days numbered. Within the last month, printed books for Seamanship are no longer available (electronic books, however, are still available). We have enough books for one more class.

So, what's different about Boat Handling? One large difference is that it is presented in a series of six seminars instead of a single class. The seminars are:

- Nautical Rules of the Road A Practical Approach
- Confidence in Docking and Undocking Slow-Speed Maneuvering
- Boating with Confidence Handling Your Boat Underway
- Anchoring with Assurance Don't Get Carried Away
- Emergencies on Board Preparation for Handling Common Problems
- Knots and Line Handling The Knots You Need to Know These seminars can also be presented to other members who desire the information, but who don't want to take the complete course. Following the seminars, those interested in completing the Boat Handling course will take an exam. Boat Handling students passing the exam will obtain the Seamanship grade. Boat Handling student materials are only available in electronic format. At the beginning of the course, a student is given a key (passcode) that allows downloading the materials from the USPS website. The materials downloaded are for the student to keep. If a printed copy is desired, the student must print his or her own. There is an on-the-water training component that goes with Boat

Handling.

In other news, I am arranging to borrow one of the USPS Boating Virtual Skills Trainer (the boat simulator) for 19-30 January, 2020. The plan is to use it for the Seamanship class that will be in session at the time, and to make it available for Squadron members to come to our HQ to try it out. Exact dates will be announced later.

After about 20 years of teaching Sail, I am handing it over to Lt. Jon Arck, S. Jon is a very experienced sailor, a licensed USCG Captain, and is certified by the American Sailing Association. He also captains a Leopard 44 catamaran. See the class advertisement elsewhere in this Afterdeck.

Disappointing Results for USPS America's Boating Course In a presentation made at the USPS Governing Board, it was disclosed that the America's Boating Course has a lot of competition out there. Also, we're not doing so well. Some of the numhers:

- There are at least 19 nationally recognized organizations that offer a Basic Boating Education Class: some offer classroom courses and some internet courses.
- Total number of people attending a course, including all types of courses, from all organizations in 2018: approximately 470,000.
- Total taking a classroom course from all organizations offering it in 2018: approximately 174,000. Total taking the online course from all organizations offering it in 2018: approximately 282,000.
- Now for the USPS numbers:

Total taking the classroom ABC3 course: 5,476. Total taking the ABC3 online course: 277.

Total taking ABC3 course, both classroom and online: **5,753**.

Over the past several months, I've had to cancel our ABC3 classes due to a lack of students. Next year, a reduced schedule of classes is planned.

We need to take action on this to improve our numbers. If for no other reason, having students take our course saves lives.




