The hotel is the **Jupiter Beach Resort & Spa** located at 5 N Hwy A1A, Jupiter, FL 33477. Please call reservations at 877-389-0571 to book your stay. Availability is limited so please call as soon as possible to guarantee your reservation. Currently the "3rd night free" promotion is the best rate available, but this is subject to change. No mention of the Maritime College reunion is necessary when booking your reservation, because a group block has not been established.

Set on 1,000 feet of private beach, this upscale resort is 2 miles from Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum. Island-inspired rooms and suites with mahogany furniture offer balconies (some with ocean views), flat-screen TVs, free Wi-Fi and coffeemakers. Upgraded rooms add wet bars with minifridges. Dining options include an oceanfront restaurant, a lounge with live entertainment, and a casual poolside bar. There's also a spa. The resort fee provides access to the outdoor pool, tennis and basketball courts, and exercise room, plus beach chairs and bike rentals. Parking is free along with fuel for us Tesla types.

Those traveling from close by are encouraged to arrive by automobile as your vehicles will be commandeered to schlep old guys and their young ladies to nearby events thus saving us all from a huge bus bill. Parking is free!

During your visit to historic Jupiter you will enjoy the weather, great food served at exotic locales, and if we are careful we just might learn some history of early life in SE Florida.
